

Ministry House/Gazebo

The lower level of the home is completely done and ready for use. During the winter we have started some necessary work upstairs. The floors in the kitchen, dining room, and bathrooms are being redone. Also, this spring we hope to be able to add a light weight roof over the deck on the backside. The sun is on the deck from sun up to sun set and it is hard on the deck surface itself. We have replaced the whole deck floor and stained the deck and rails. So, to protect our investment we need to put a protective roof over the deck. We are looking at fiberglass roof panels supported by a wood structure. We have some of the funds to do that in the Ministry House reserve account but will need a few more donations to finish the project. It is estimated to cost arount \$1,600 in materials to do the deck and we have around \$1,000 so we are looking for \$600.00 to complete the project.
