Why does it take more time to do things than you think it will? It seems we usually underestimate the time. Why? 1) We think we are quicker than we are! 2) There are things in the process we weren't expecting! 3) Our attention gets diverted or changed in the process! 4) OK, we are slow!! I am sure you can think of other reasons as well. Whatever the reason there are variables we cannot control.

A dictionary says Variable is "An element, feature, or factor that is liable to vary or change." "There are too many variables involved to make any meaningful prediction." Our lives are full of variables. There may be more traffic one day or as I found today they were working on the bridge. Or maybe someone calls in the middle of your project and you have to take time to answer the call. And the call causes you to change what you are doing and come back to it later. There are literally hundreds of variables in life. And each variable is linked to time so what can we do?

The main thing is to accept the variables and cope with time as it is given to you. Most accidents are caused by worry and trying to do something to speed up the process. Then we are not careful enough to cope with the variable and that can have tragic consequenses.

How to cope with variables of life? Faith! Faith in God to show you the way even if it takes longer. Faith in Jesus to save us from making a big mistake. And faith in the Holy Spirit to guide, uphold and encourage us with life and all its decisions. Variables—Yes! Faith in God, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit—Yes! Why, because all three persons of God can help us cope with time. We are governed too much by time. God's timing is much better and safer for that matter. Putting our faith into God's timing allows us to be free to respond to the variables of life. In fact, God's timing is perfect! Faith, Hope and Love, abide these three but the greatest "in this circumstance" is Faith. Have faith in God's timing and make it your own!
