New Addition Dedication

The "Welcome Center/Office Complex" will have an official dedication on May 3, 2015. You will be receiving an official invitation to attend this celebration. Please look for it in the mail because it has a reservation card in it which I will get to in a minute. Dwight Chapman, our Assistant to the District Superintendent will be here to help dedicate our addition to the Glory of God our Father. Bart Hildreth, our District Superintendent is invited but may not be able to be here due to this being the time of year that all the appointments need to be secured. If Bart is here he too will be a part of the dedication.

The morning will be as usual-the Welcome Center will be open from 9:45 to 10:25.

At 10:30 we will have our regular morning worship, our focus is thanking God for helping us to plan, finish, and now dedicate our facility. Our goal is to bring people to know Jesus Christ and help them function as His disciples.

At 12:00 we will enjoy a catered meal. This is where the invitation card will reserve a spot for you at the dinner. Also, our vendors (where we bought materials) and subcontractors who did work for us will be invited to come and celebrate as well. Cake, coffee and juice will be served during the open house.


