As we begin this Fall pray about the direction of our church. We will have "outreach meetings" again this Fall. We will be asking God's help in bringing other people to be disciples of Jesus Christ.

We are alive in Jesus Christ but we need to share that with others to bring them into our midst.



We are gong to try something new. Instead of the first Saturday of the month we will try the first Sunday. So, for October we will meet at 8:00 a.m. Sunday October 7. We will be done in time for Sunday School at 9:30 a.m. and Worship at 10:30 a.m.

We hope this will allow more men of the church to be a part of this ministry. Our format will be breakfast, a short meeting to talk about men's ministry and finances for that ministry. We will end with a devotional time. Wives of the men are encouraged to come as well and be a part of this ministry.

#### Welcome Center/Office Complex

The Church Council has approved a motion that we bring the Welcome Center/Office Complex to a congregation vote.

On Sunday, October 14 we will vote on our Welcome Center/ Office Complex addition to the church. The model will be on display in the narthex Sunday, September 29 - October 14.

We will have a short presentation after worship on the 14th and then vote to increase the number by secret ballot to say Yes or No to the following:

A Worship Center/Offlice Complex building shall be attached to the north side of the church and shall be the proposed footage of 36'x44' with the cost of the new addition not to exceed \$72,000.

The Church Council approved the financing of the project by using existing funds (\$9000 CD), to acquire donations from members and friends of the church and to mortgage the balance.

The October 14 voting is by the members and active friends of the church who attend that voting session. The "Discipline" of the UMC does not allow absentee voting so you will need to be there. We are hoping for an excellent turn out for this session. We need you all there! Also, it has been established that we need a 75/25 vote, 75% for building with only 25% not in favor.
